- Airbases and aircraft

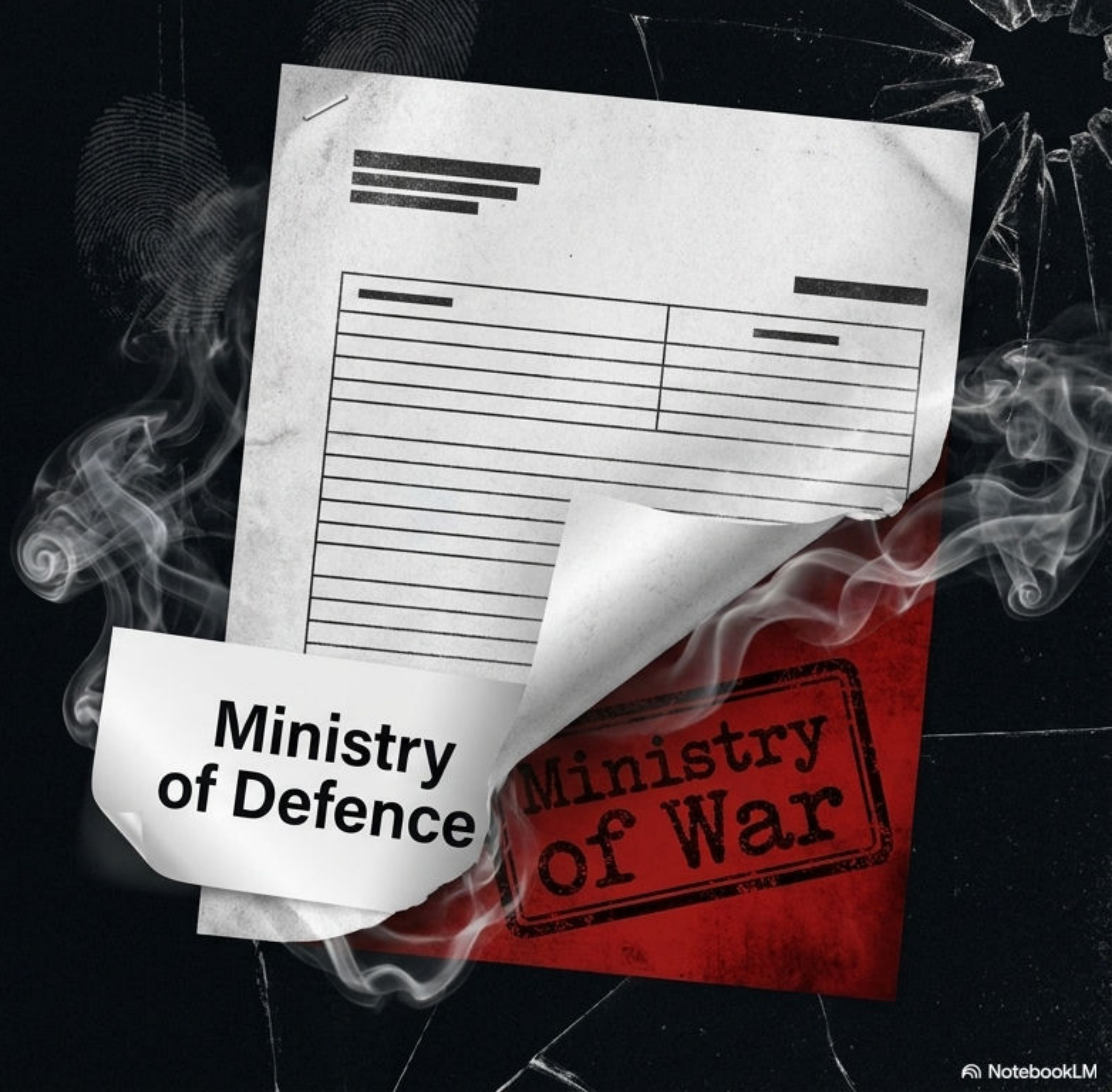
Every corner of the border faces a threat dressed in security.

Illusion

Creating an unrealistic image of the world and Iran's position.



Betrayal and Immorality
