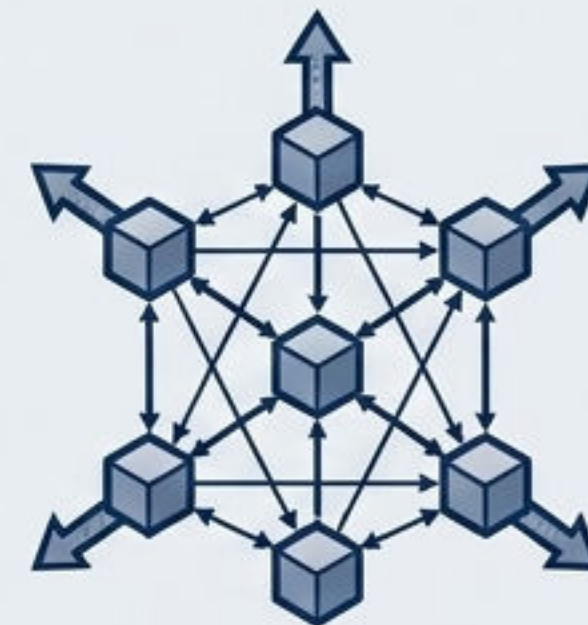
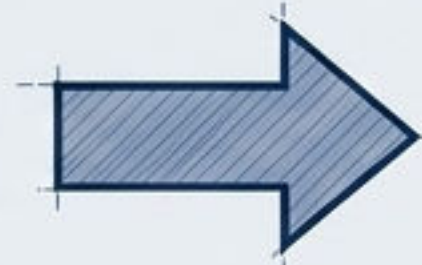
The US War Cycle and 'Absorbing' Management

The True Nature of War

War is not just about executing an attack; victory lies in the ability to manage the consequences (the 'absorbing' phase).

The Role of Naval Fleets

The accumulation of US ships and equipment in the region is specifically designed for the 'post-attack management' phase.

The Strategic Objective

Inducing passivity. America aims to absorb our offensive power and naval forces to neutralise our counter-strike.

Strategic Depth: The Impossibility of a Missile Siege



Geographic Reality:

- We are not Hezbollah to be besieged in a small area (Dahiyeh). Iran's "Underground Missile Cities" are distributed across the entirety of the country.

Tactical Supremacy:

- The enemy is mathematically and physically incapable of suppressing all launch points simultaneously.

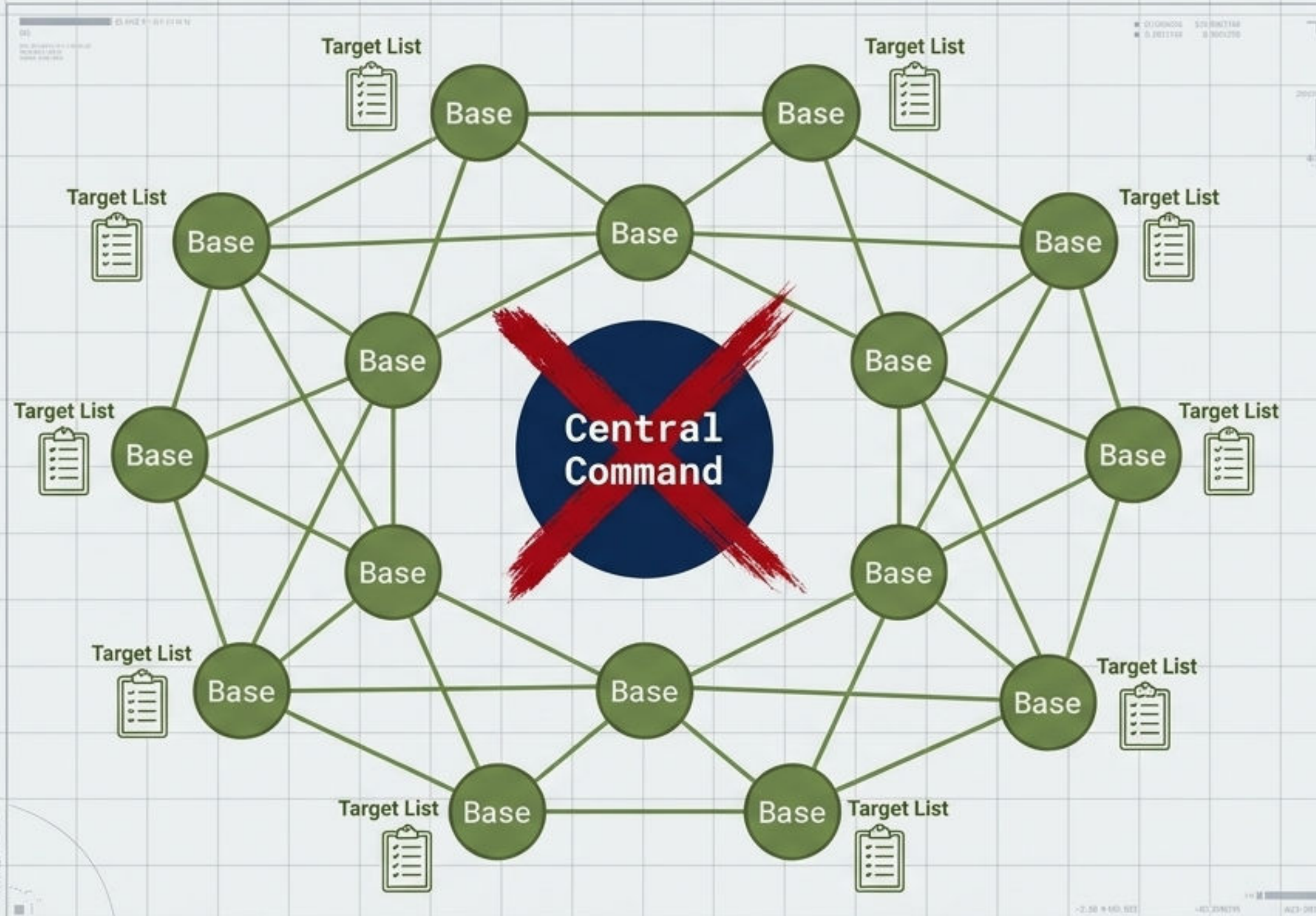
Regional Reach:

- Accessible targets are firmly within range: Kuwait, UAE, Jordan, Qatar, and Israel.

Lethality Metric:

- In the first two days of our recent engagement, we fired a volume equivalent to 8 days of the 12-day war against Israel.

The 'Farm' Plan: Decentralised Command Doctrine



The 'Farm' (Mazraeh) Concept:

Total dispersion of operational bases to guarantee survival.

Autonomous Operation:

In the event of a total communication blackout with central command, every single base possesses a pre-assigned target list and executes strikes completely independently. Every base becomes its own command centre.

Historical Precedent:

History has proven that any nation possessing the ultimate will to resist can stand firm against America.

The Phase Shift: From Air War to Urban Insurgency



- ⚙️ **The Strategic Pivot:** When the enemy realises they cannot contain our missile parity, their strategy devolves into engineering a 'civil war'.
- 🎯 **The Adversary's End Goal:** The ultimate objective of Netanyahu and Trump is to manufacture chaos, riots, and armed conflict directly within Tehran and other major urban centres.
- 📦 **The Second Component of War:** The deliberate transfer of the theatre of conflict from the external borders to the domestic streets.

The Ultimate Reality:

The goal is absolutely not military victory; the objective is total security breakdown and the normalisation of anarchy in the cities.

Why attack police stations and Basij zones? To weaken the domestic security net and prepare the ground for armed rebellion.

Intent: Why target the Mehran border post? To pave the way and open secure corridors for terrorist group infiltration.

The 'Antidote': The Street Capture Strategy



The Danger of the Void

If the public arena remains empty, armed insurgency quickly takes shape to fill the vacuum.

The Strategic Antidote:

The relentless, physical presence of the people in the streets, mosques, and intersections.

Tactical Denial:

When the street is physically 'captured' by the public, the enemy instantly loses the spatial capacity for armed manoeuvre.

Today: External Front

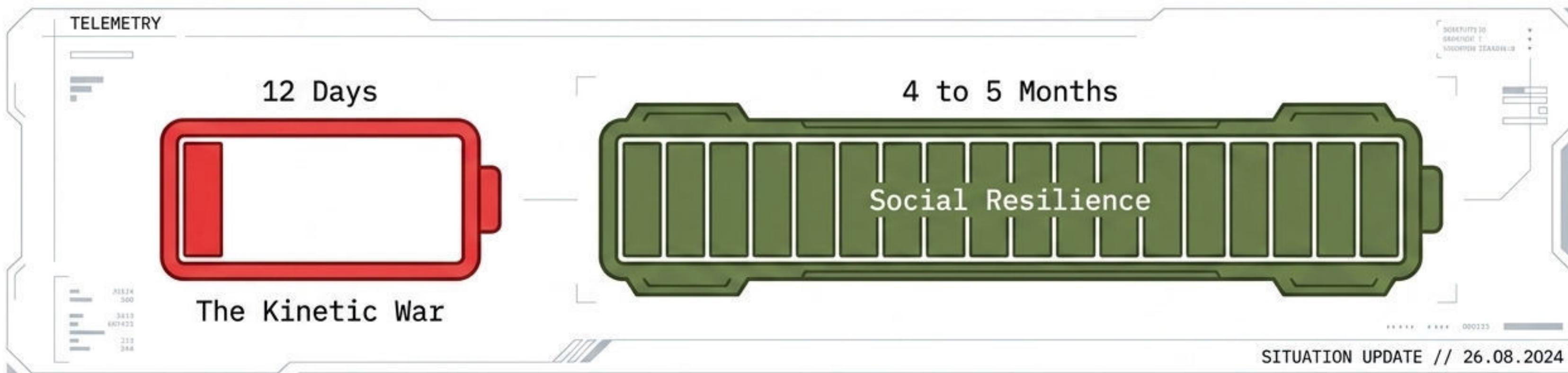


Today: Internal Front



- ★ **The Dual Reality:** We are operating under conditions identical to Year 60: fighting a simultaneous war on two entirely different fronts.
- ★ **Front Breakdown:** Classic kinetic and missile warfare defending the external borders, while simultaneously combating armed terrorists and insurgents within the capital.
- ★ **The Verdict:** Just as we achieved victory then, we will win now through unyielding vigilance.

Expectation Management

This is not a brief 10 or 20-day skirmish. Citizens must mentally prepare for a conflict that may span 4 to 5 months.

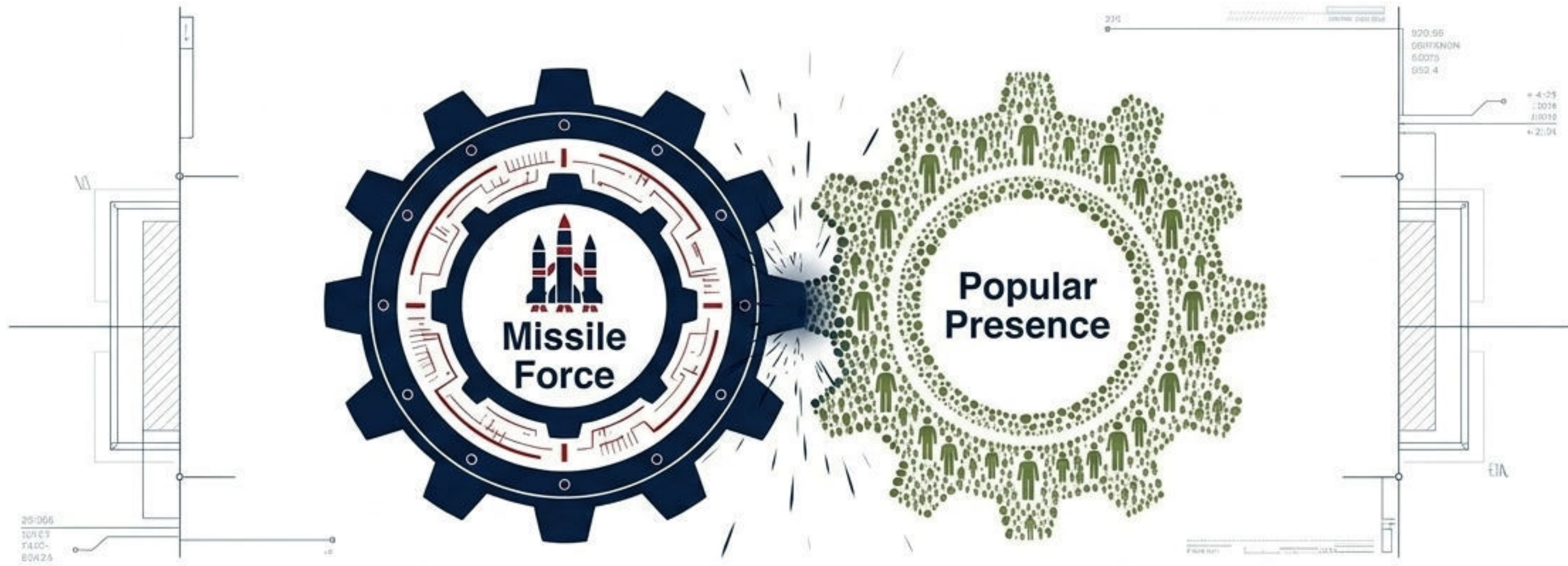
The Law of Attrition

In this phase, the definitive winner is simply the one who can resist one day longer than the adversary.

Historical Proof

The National Division of Labour: Missiles from Us, Streets from You



- ★ **The Societal Contract:** The missile force will execute its duties flawlessly. Your paramount duty is the capture and control of the streets.
- ★ **Information Discipline:** Do not allow your mind to be distracted by political margins or parliamentary news noise.
- ★ **Absolute Focus:** Maintain total concentration on the dual front: Missile War + Urban War.

1. Vigilance (Information Control)

3. Patience (Resilience Battery)
